

PETITION TO EITHER REMEDY SECURITY OR SHUT DOWN THE STAR LOUNGE

Dear Guests and Residents:

For at least the past two months, on a regular basis, the Star Lounge (i.e. the club in the basement of the Hotel Chelsea) has been the source of a number of serious concerns:

- 1) Excessive Noise from Patrons Outside the Club
- 2) Consistent Obstruction of the Entrance to the Hotel by Loitering Patrons
- 3) Verbal and Physical Harassment of Residents by Club Security

And lastly

- 4) An Unwillingness to Remedy Above Complaints After Repeated Notification from both Guests, Residents and Local Police

After numerous attempts to address these concerns with Hotel Management (Arnold Tamasar and Andrew Tilley) – WITHOUT RESULT – we are now asking for signatures on this petition to forward on to local officials: the 10th Precinct, Speaker Christine Quinn, Senator Tom Duane, Community Board 4, and the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms, with the objective of bringing pressure to bear on the Club's owners and Hotel Management to remedy these problems which consistently disturb the quiet enjoyment of our residence.
